

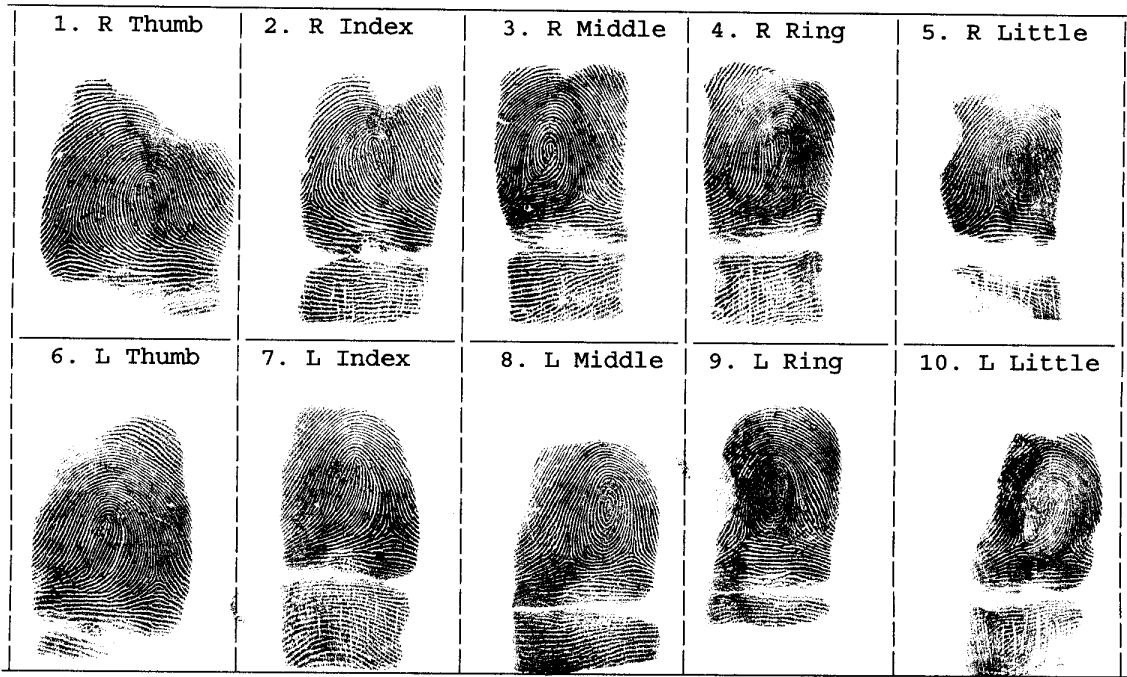



- Habitual Violent Felony Offender _ The defendant is adjudicated a habitual violent felony offender and has been sentenced to an extended term in accordance with the provisions of section 775.084(4)(b), Florida Statutes. A minimum term of _____ years must be served prior to release. The requisite findings of the court are set forth in a separate order or stated on the record in open court.




